# HARB⇔RMASTER REP★RT

Thank you to all FLHPOA harbor members for an amazing and smooth 2024 boating season! Now let's focus ahead on the 2025 season. See the next page for information about HARBOR REGISTRATION.

The board has approved a maintenance dredge on Bayview inlet to increase the depths coming in and out of the harbor. A depth study conducted in the summer of 2024 revealed that significant silt and sand deposits have started to fill in the inlet, making it too shallow for larger boats with deep drafts to navigate. A similar depth study was conducted at Chesney, where, to our surprise, depths are still good– matching or even exceeding the lake's average pool level in some areas.

All the expenditure details can be found in the FLHPOA Harbor Fund accounting report, which is shared at our monthly meetings. Please join us sometime to hear about what the board is doing to continually improve our community, parks, beaches, and harbor. Meetings are always held on the third Wednesday of each month, and all residents are encouraged to attend.

### 2025 FLHPOA HARBOR REGISTRATION

Sunday, March 2 From 1pm To 3pm

- The deadline to pre-register is March 2. NOTE: If you do not pre-register by the deadline, you may lose your slip, even if you attend the main in-person registration event on March 2. Online pre-registration is required in advance for all new and existing FLHPOA harbor members.
- **STEP 2** Gather your verification documents from the pre-registration process and have them ready for the March 2<sup>nd</sup> event, or schedule an Early Bird meeting with a harbormaster to complete your registration. *REQUIRED DOCUMENTS: a copy of active watercraft, a copy of current watercraft registration, and a paid receipt of your 2025 HOA dues.*
- STEP 3 Print out the harbor rules and regulations from the bottom of <a href="https://foxlakehills.org/meetings-events/harbor-registration/">https://foxlakehills.org/meetings-events/harbor-registration/</a>, then sign and date them. Have these ready to turn in at the March 2<sup>nd</sup> event, or bring them to your Early Bird meeting.
- STEP 4 (This step is NOT required for Early Bird registrants)
  Line up between 1pm and 3pm on March 2 at the
  Lake Villa Township Community Center. Volunteers
  will verify your documents, collect your signed rules
  and regulations, collect payment, and provide your
  keys/slip number or add you to a waiting list if you
  are new to the harbor or rejoining after a break.

#### WANT TO BYPASS THE IN-PERSON EVENT?

Try **EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION** by scheduling a 1-on-1 meeting with an FLHPOA harbormaster to avoid the March 2 event entirely! *NOTE: The Early Bird 1-on-1 schedule will be released in January via the website and email after we receive the keys and permit stickers from our vendors.*

\$300 Boat Slip (\$210) + Ramp Key (\$90)

\$100 Initial fee for new harbor members

\$50 Inconvenience fee (for residents who register after the in-person event on March 2<sup>nd</sup>)

Note, if you want a dock box installed at your slip, you may make the appropriate selection in the registration for the footer and the box.

# FEELING THE SQUEEZE OF HIGHER UTILITY BILLS?

#### Try these suggestions from familyhandyman.com...

- Replace worn-out weatherstripping around doors
- Adjust your door threshold or install a door sweep
- Locate window leaks & seal them with caulk
- Use heat-shrink plastic window film
- Consider using thicker curtains or dual-cell honeycomb shades & keep them closed at night
- Open window coverings when the sun is out
- Insulate & seal air leaks in attics/crawl spaces
- Close your fireplace damper when it's not in use
- Fill gaps around electrical outlets & switches
- Clean fridge coils & check temperature (38–40°)

- Drain the water heater and lower the temperature
- Insulate the water heater and exposed water pipes
- Take shorter showers
- Use cold water to wash clothes
- Keep your dryer duct clean
- Switch to a thermostat that can be scheduled to reduce temperatures at night and/or while away
- Change your furnace filter regularly
- Plug electronics into a power strip & turn off the power strip when not in use

# DO YOU HAVE A WINTER SAFETY KIT?

#### According to the American Red Cross, an emergency kit should contain:

- One gallon of water per person per day, up to a 2-week supply
- A 2-week supply of easy-to-prepare, non-perishable food
- First aid kit
- 7-day supply of medications
- Sanitation and personal hygiene items
- Emergency blanket
- Multi-purpose tool or toolkit

- Flashlights
- Extra batteries
- Cell phone with chargers
- Battery- or crank-powered radio
- Cash
- · Family and emergency contact info
- Copies of personal documents (e.g., medical information and list of medications, birth certificates, proof of address, insurance policies)

	Test all smoke and carbon monoxide detectors Replace batteries, if needed.
	Get your HVAC system inspected. Replace filters.
